# WHAT ARE STREET ART OPERAS?



Short operas of up to 10 minutes shown outdoors, projected onto a wall and listened to on wireless headphones.



They use graphic or animation techniques sometimes involving green-screen filming.



They should include opera singing but can also include other types of singing.



The music can be of any type from hip hop to classical. You can use any instruments and sounds.

The pieces can be in Welsh, English or any other language. Words will be projected bi-lingually in Welsh and English.

The words will be part of the main graphic image.
